



Copyright and Digital Millennium Copyright Act Requirements

Net253, LLC (Net253) requires all Users to comply with U.S. copyright and related laws. Accordingly, Users may not store any material or content on, disseminate or make available for dissemination any material or content over, the Service (or any part of the Service) in any manner that constitutes an infringement of third party intellectual property rights, including rights granted by U.S. copyright law.

1. Using the Service for the transmission or storage of copyright-protected material without the consent of the relevant rights holders may be an infringement under U.S. copyright law and could give rise to criminal and civil liability.
2. Net253 does not assume any responsibility for material available, transmitted, stored or otherwise accessible through the Service. However, owners of copyrighted works who in good faith believe that material appearing on the Internet infringes their rights under U.S. copyright law and resides on the Service or is made available as part of the Service may report alleged infringements by sending Net253 a notification of claimed infringement that satisfies the requirements of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998 (the "DMCA") to the address listed below. Upon receipt of a satisfactory notice, Net253 will respond expeditiously to remove or disable the allegedly infringing work or disable access to it, and to notify the affected User of the Service of the removal or disabling of access.
3. A User who receives a notification of alleged infringement from Net253 as described above, and believes in good faith that the alleged infringing works have been removed or blocked by mistake or misidentification, may send a counter-notification that complies with the DMCA to Net253 at the address listed below. Upon receipt of a satisfactory counter-notice, Net253 will promptly provide a copy of the counter notification to the person who sent the original notification of claimed infringement and will follow the DMCA's procedures with respect to a received counter notification.
4. Consistent with the requirements of the U.S. Copyright Act, if the copyright owner does not bring a lawsuit in district court within 14 days, Net253 will restore the material to its location on its network.
